

## **Dream Cage – Instructor Taryn Reece**

Capture your dreams in this whimsical project where we will create a mixed media wire cage. In this workshop we will explore building a wire cage utilizing common objects, simple wire work and various attachment techniques. We will also use an easy-stitch technique to create a focal point inside the cage. Adding fibers, transparency collages and treasure bits completes the dreamy transformation.

### **Supply List students need to bring:**

- Vintage Image Transparencies (kit includes some images perfectly sized for the project but feel free to bring some of your favorites as well)
- Acrylic Paints (any brand, assorted colors)
- Paint Brushes (any brand, assorted sizes/shapes)
- Acrylic sealer (matte finish, any brand)
- Gel Medium (Golden or any brand)
- Tacky Glue
- Scissors & Craft Knife
- Needle & Assorted Threads
- String/Twine
- Wire – you will need approx 48 yards+ of 22-24 gauge wire
- Pliers – Needlenose/jewelry type(s) – it is nice to have an assortment on hand as we will be using them for jump rings/wire wrapping, etc (there will be some to share as well)
- Stapler and Extra Staples (will have some to share but you may want your own)
- Sandpaper (I prefer to use a sandpaper block – asst grits and easier to hold)
- Bring your favorites from your stash:
  - Decorative/scrapbook paper
  - Vintage Papers – such as old ledger paper, sheet music, text, etc
  - Lots of Treasure Bits - Various Beads, Buttons, Washers, Old Keys, Trinkets, Game Pieces, Small Feathers and Found Objects
  - Assorted small bits of fabric, fiber, lace, ribbon, tulle
