Jump in and get foot loose with a new adventure in altered miniatures assemblage. In this workshop we will explore building a composition reminiscent of a fairy house but in a very non-literal fashion. A combination of wire work, natural materials, junk drawer specials and miniature furniture and architectural components will be used in untraditional ways to create a delightful and intriguing sculpture.

Supply List students need to bring:

- High heeled shoe, preferably strappy
- A book large enough for the shoe to sit on
- A favorite poem or verse (to be copied on watercolor paper in class)
- Liquid Nails - tube with caulking gun
- Titanium White tube acrylic and a few artists brushes
- Junk - ideas include: nuts/bolts, hinges, electrical stuff, interesting spoon, fork or other flatware, little bottles, sea glass, tiny mirrors, upholstery tacks or drapery tacks, bits of natural materials (instructor will have lots on hand to play with), any miniatures that might need a new life - broken chairs, chandeliers, teapots - (instructor will supply as well), pretty beads and some fiber, feathers, velvet bits, ribbon, fabric scraps
- Instructor will have lots of "junk" to pick from as well as paint other than the titanium white tube.
